

GREENVILLE CHORALE YOUNG ARTIST INFORMATION

The Greenville Chorale, to encourage young and talented singers in the choral art, is sponsoring this project as a community outreach effort.

The purpose of the Chorale Young Artist Program is:

1. to encourage those young singers with outstanding ability and interest to pursue the choral art with experience singing with adult voices in performances of great choral-orchestral music, and
2. to enhance the choral leadership of those young singers in their ongoing high school choral activities.

There is NO FINANCIAL obligation on the part of the high school singers selected as a Greenville Chorale Young Artist. There are a limited number of positions available. If you are selected, your high school choral program will receive a \$500 honorarium to be used by your choral director.

Greenville Chorale Young Artist expectations:

- ◆ Attend all Chorale rehearsals for the appropriate concert. Rehearsals are held on Monday nights from 7:30-9:30 at Harper Hall at Furman University. There will be additional rehearsals during concert week.
- ◆ Personal illness or death in family will be the only acceptable reason for any absence from the rehearsal schedule.
- ◆ Practice on their own time those portions of the music they find difficult to learn.
- ◆ Gentlemen will be expected to wear a tuxedo for the performance(s) and Ladies will be expected to wear a long black skirt, a long sleeved, round neck top and black shoes for performance(s).

A veteran member of the Greenville Chorale will be assigned to each Young Artist to serve as a mentor to assist the young singer.

Your letter of recommendation must be included in the mailed application or digitally with an emailed application. (see application for more information)

Auditions will be held in Harper Hall at Furman University on January 24, 2016 for the spring concert and May 22, 2016 for the 2016-2017 concert season.
